RE: FLORIDA STATISTICAL REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

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Effective January 1, 1997, the Florida Department of Insurance will require each underwriter to collect additional statistical data to be used in future rate making. Old Republic's policy reporting systems are such that we only need minimal additional input from each agent which can be hand written under the policy amount on Schedule A of each policy remitted.

The first thing required is the "property type" in accordance with the following codes:

R = Residential (single family)  
O = Other residential  
C = Commercial/Industrial  
L = Land (vacant)  
U = Other

Next, a county code is required. Our computers are programmed to enter the county code for the county where you are located. If the policy remitted is out of county, kindly use a check mark next to the property type code to alert our processors.

Lastly, we need to know if a mortgage is a construction loan or a second (or more junior) mortgage. For a construction loan, please indicate with the letter "X." For a junior lien, a "J." These too should be written by the policy amount on Schedule A.
